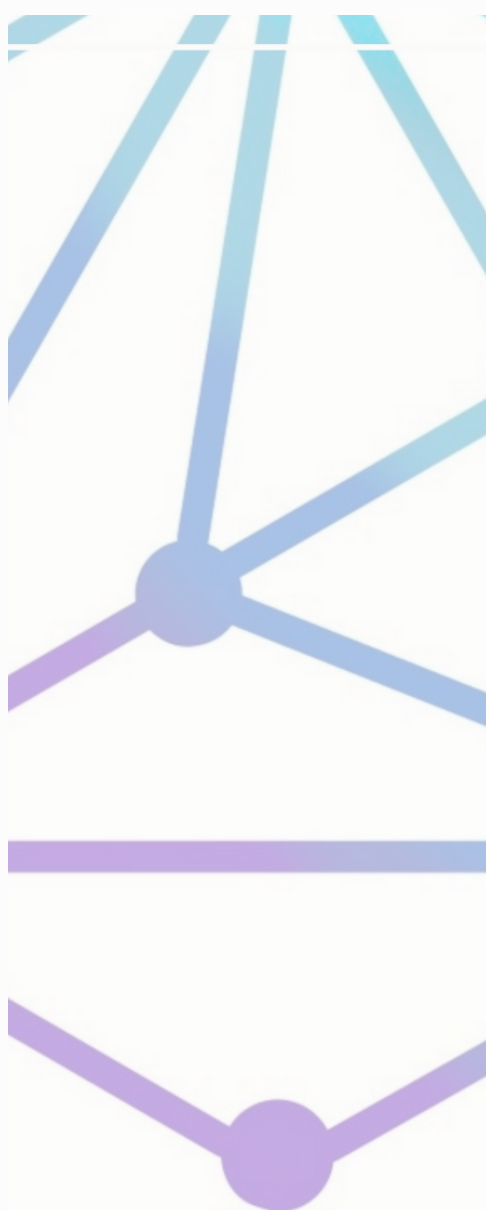

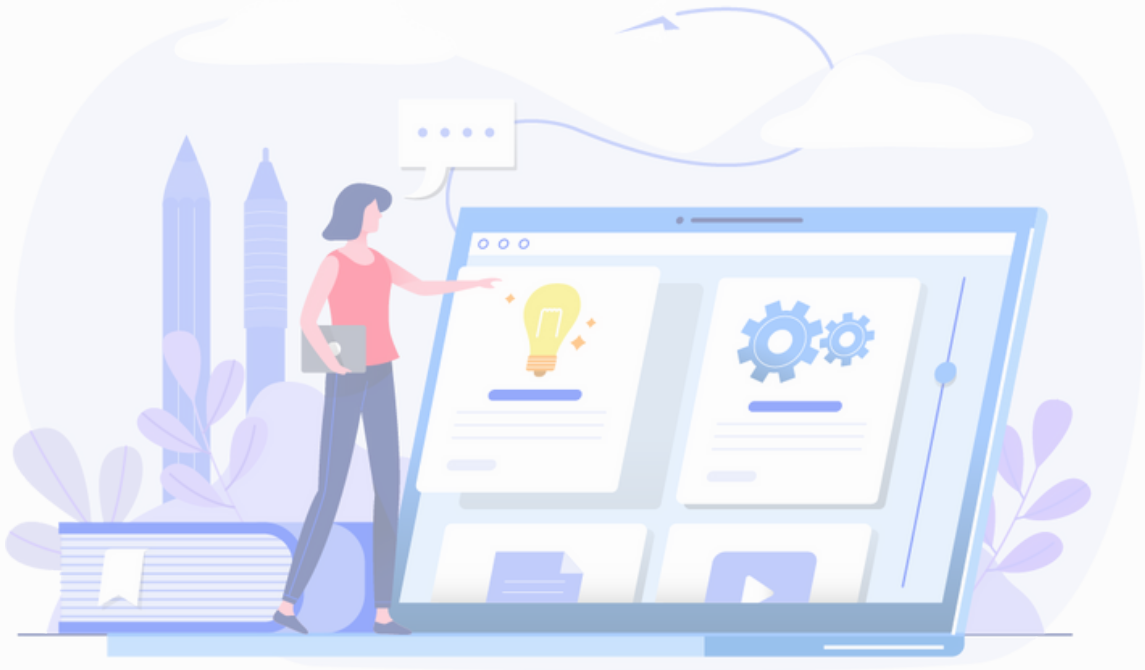
Key Components
